## 1. Message from the Chair

2019 was a very active year for Norway India Chamber of Commerce and Industry. We organized 9 events for members and stakeholders. Knowledge- and experience sharing was the priority. Creating new arenas for networking and reaching a bigger part of possible members has also been important for us this year.

I 2019 we launched two new concepts: "India Business Day" and "Startup meets Corporate".

The first "India Business Day" in Oslo, attracted more than 200 participants and was Cohosted with all our dedicated partners. With 5 parallel sessions following the plenum program, we reached a broad aspect of relevant companies in the Norway-India business community.

"Start-up meets corporate" will be a key event going forward as the win-win situation for the businesses involved and it taps into the key interest and added value for NICCI members.

## 2. Mission

Norway India Chamber of Commerce and Industry (NICCI) is an independent association whose purpose is to promote business relations between Norway and India. NICCI provide a network between individuals, companies, organizations and authorities.

Events, workshops and meetings are organized to facilitate collaboration and knowledge transfer, and in general to provide members with updated information about political, economic, cultural or legislative issues relevant to business and commerce.

We collaborate with several organizations both in India and Norway. Among them, the Indian Embassy in Norway, the Norwegian Embassy in India, Royal Norwegian Consulate General in Mumbai, the Federation of Norwegian Enterprise (NHO), the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI), the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), the Norwegian Business Association in India (NBAI), the Research Council of Norway and Innovation Norway.

## 3. Summary 2019

NICCI organized and co-organized 9 member events in 2019. One of them was our largest event ever, the large format **India Business Day** in Oslo in June.

#### The Board of NICCI held 5 Board meetings in 2019.

Throughout the year, the Board and administration has prioritized being represented and relevant at important Norway-India business arenas.

In 2019 the administration had a strong focus on staying in regular touch with the most important stakeholders in Norway-India business, both in Norway and in India. This has resulted is close relations and very good cooperation, in particular with Innovation Norway, Embassy of India, the Norwegian Embassy in India, the Consulate General in Mumbai, Norwegian Business Association India, The Research Council of Norway, the Ministry of foreign affairs and the Ministry of Trade, Industry and Fisheries.

In 2019 NICCI members were invited to a number of relevant external events, meetings and the business delegation to India with Prime Minister Erna Solberg in January.


## 5. Administration



#### 23. May:


#### **Election Post Festum at Litteraturhuset, Oslo**


#### **Event featuring world class angel investor from Mumbai Shravan Shroff**
