2. Mission

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3. Summary 2022

NICCI organized and co-organized 14 meetings/events in 2022. Most of them physical meetings, but we continued organizing digital sessions since we have members spread across Norway and India.



We have during the year started activities to establish company consortiums. Groups of companies joining forces towards identified market opportunities. We started with the energy sector and has partnered up with external partners and will get in operation in first half of 2023.

In October we organized a NICCI busines delegation to India. Around 25 members participated in all or parts of our meetings and events in Delhi and Mumbai. In Delhi we visited the World Bank, Invest India and had a market seminar with Innovation Norway and a session with Anita George, board member in TATA and Director Edhina Capital. The Norwegian Embassy hosted a networking dinner. In Mumbai we had a seminar with Norwegian companies in India hosted by the Norwegian consulate general, that also hosted a networking dinner. The delegates participated in several site visits in Delhi and Mumbai.

The Board of NICCI held 5 meetings throughout the year.


